

Volvo Ocean Race 2017-18 Virtual Regatta competition

Terms and conditions v2.0 9 November 2017

- The winner will be the first member of the GAC fleet, having joined that fleet by entering the code GACVOR1718 when prompted after registering, to cross the finish line at the Cardiff stopover. This is to allow time for prize travel planning and booking. The winner will be the highest GAC fleet member over the entire race (6 best legs – see Race/Leg switch top right of fleet ranking), not only Leg 9 (Newport to Cardiff).
- Entrants must join the game by 00:00 UTC (GMT) Wednesday 22 November 2017.
- The prize consists of two return flights or train tickets (where practical) from within the EUR region to Rotterdam The Hague airport, The Netherlands, up to 3 nights in a hotel selected by GAC UK between Friday 29 June and Monday 2 July, plus €200 spending money. The Gothenburg stopover may be selected as an alternative if acceptable to the Group Vice President, Europe.
- There is no cash or other alternative prize or cash or other alternative to any aspect of it, for example cash instead of flights if the winner chooses to travel by car, unless the winner is a Team GAC Pindar or other colleague who will be in The Hague working anyway. The alternative in this situation will be decided and advised by the Group Vice President, Europe.
- If the winner is unable to travel on the dates, the prize will be awarded to the runner-up.
- The winner, if a GAC employee, will not need to take annual leave for the one weekday spent in The Hague but will need to take leave to cover any voluntary extension of the trip.
- The competition is open to friends and family of GAC staff and players outside of the EUR region. Winners from other regions will need to fund their own travel to The Hague but will receive a contribution of €500 towards the cost.
- Play and entry is governed by the capabilities and features of the game as explained in the comprehensive Virtual Regatta [help pages](#). FAQs are extensive - please ask Google or a fellow sailor if you can't find the answer to your question there.
- The decision of the Group Vice President, Europe, on any disputes arising during the competition, is final.
